The juried annual art show is held the first Saturday in November, in Cincinnati, Ohio. The scholarships are intended for students up to age 24 who wish to develop their artistic talents and further develop their appreciation of art. Scholarships are solely for the purpose of art education through The Art Academy of Cincinnati.

The scholarships are for the following classes offered by The Art Academy of Cincinnati:
Portfolio Prep – a class is intended to engage high school sophomores, juniors and seniors in the preparation of their portfolio for college admissions. Community Art Class – summer classes are designed to give students (10-12) and teens (13-17) a good foundation in a variety of visual arts disciplines.
